1. The Government of Uttar Pradesh, through Govt of India has received financing from the World Bank amount of US\$ 330 million toward the cost of the Uttar Pradesh Core Road Network Development Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for consulting services.

The NGO services ("the Services") is to facilitate the affected community in their resettlement and rehabilitation processes and help UP PWD in the implementation of Resettlement Action Plan in 220 kms lengths 06 Nos of State Highways in compliance with the relevant procedures of contractual documents of UPCRNDP.

Interested NGOs should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short-listing criteria are:
 - i. The NGO must have been registered before year 2010.
 - ii. Must have carried out NGO services for implementation of resettlement action plan of at least two linear project (state or national Highway or railways or transmission lines Project) or more funded by multilateral funding agency.
 - iii. Must have experience of working in similar region.
 - iv. The NGO must have the experience of facilitating land acquisition on at least one highway project.
 - v. Turn over must be at least 25 lakhs.
5. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 and November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
6. An NGO will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection method set out in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations July 2016, revised November 2017, August 2018 and November 2020".
